Cavell) was 19. At this time Edwin and Annabella lived in Bittern, Victoria.

Albert's parents were married on 1st March 1883 in the Church of England in Mornington, Vic.

Albert Corry died on July 20th, 1949 and is buried at the Northern Suburbs Cemetery, 197 New Delhi Road, North Ryde, NSW and lies in plot *C.V. 4 at the western end of the Colurabariums at the base of a pencil pine.

Albert Corry, a carpet layer/planner at 30 married Marjory Jane Wilson, a music teacher aged 31 at St. Stephen's Cathedral in Brisbane, Qld. on April 7th, 1913. From the details on their Marriage Certificate, Albert's address was Cathedral Street, Sydney and Marjory's was Jubilee Terrace, Paddington, Brisbane. The Marriage Certificate was signed by a Fr. William Lee the presiding Catholic Priest, and by Marjory's parents Emma Wilson (nee Barraclough) and James Joss Wilson, and by Edwin's brother Theodore Wilson as witnesses.

Albert had eight siblings: Catherine Frances, Elma, Theodore, Sorell, Celest, Lillian May, Herbert Clarence and Eileen Hazel.

Wife's Notes

Marjory was born at 3:55am at 6 Norfolk Street in Glasgow, District of Gorbals in the County of Lanark, Scotland. Birth Reg.#1561. Her parents were James Joss Wilson, Tailor's Cutter, and Emma Wilson nee Barraclough who were married on October 11th 1880 in Leeds, England.

Marjory was the youngest of six children. Her siblings were: Alexander, James Joss, Mary Hannah, Florence Mary and Emma.
