- 1 <u>A Group Accommodation Package</u> is in advanced negotiation with the RACV/T Apartment Hotel in Hobart. It has ample on-site parking, spacious reception areas for Group assembly, and front door Coach pickup. RACV/T would be the hub for all of our group assembly and coach pickups. Further advice will be available in due course.
- 2 <u>RYCT (Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania)</u> a first class facility on the Sandy Bay foreshore with spacious group dining rooms, both internal and external. Good for the young ones too.
